Rev'd John's Sermon Outline

MARK 10: 32- 45

* vs 32. Jesus demonstrates selfless determination in carrying out His Father's will. His disciples were astonished and afraid.

* vs 37. James and John demonstrate selfish determination in persuing their own desires

* vs 45 . Jesus teaches his disciples what true greatness is really about.

LESSONS today for us as God's church.

1. We learn how determination is easily corrupted .James /John wanted to pursue their own ambitions.

2.True greatness is found only in a determination to die to self and serve others : John 3:30 ; Phil 2:3-5

3.Jesus our Model and our means for true greatness. The Holy Spirit to guide us. The old has gone , the new is here: 2 Cor 5:17
