Mark 10: 46-52. Bartimaeus Faith. Persistence. Passion. Courageous .

* We need to understand our need.

* We must pray and believe that our Lord will quicken our Faith .1 Peter 1:8

*vs 47 - An example of determined Perseverance in the face of personal difficulties

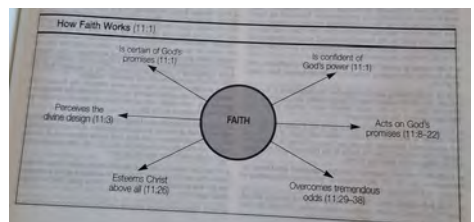
*vs 48. Little encouragement from those around him. He was courageous and overcame the rebukes of bystanders.

*vs 52. Bartimaeus followed Jesus. He was freely Pardoned and Healed.

* Like Bartimaeus , we need to be Persistent;Passionate and Courageous in our Faith walk...and Patience .. He demonstrated REAL Faith .
