### **Rev'd John's Sermon Outline**

Eph 1:7 : THE RICHES OF GOD'S GRACE Inexhaustible ,boundless and all sufficient!

" In Christ or In Him is repeated several times by Paul.

Vs 4 . " For he chose us in Him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in His sight. Paul rejoices that God chooses people for a relationship with Himself:

This is "The Riches of His Grace"
