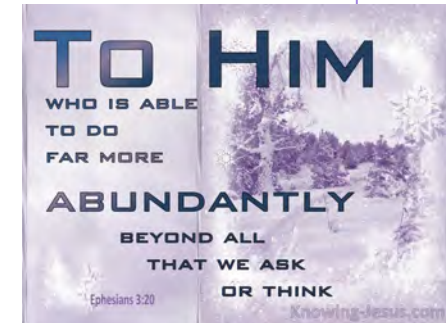

Our God will act, He is not idle

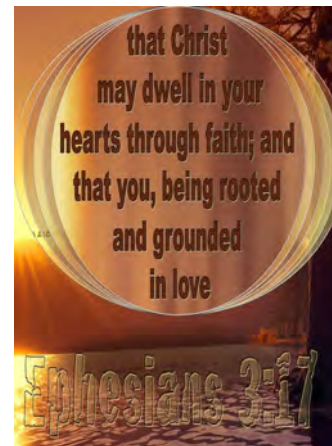
Hab 2:3 Though it lingers, wait for it, it will certainly come'
