MARK 6: 1-6-13

In these verses, We are being called to be mindful of the critical disciplines of the Christian life, to allow the Holy Spirit to bring us into absolute HARMONY with the teachings of Jesus.

- *vs 3.We note how the people were offended by the teachings of Jesus.
 - " Is not this the carpenter ,son of Mary?
