3 vs 10. We are God's workmanship!

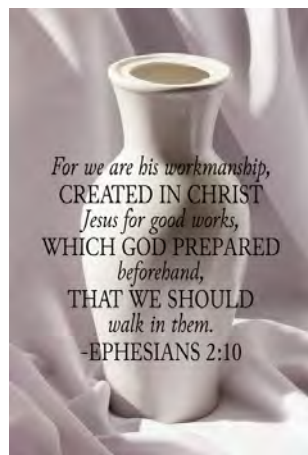
