

Reflect on today's sentence


Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you.

COLOSSIANS 2 .6-18

THE GLORIOUS MYSTERY OF CHRIST LIVING IN YOU AND ME.

*vs 1. A call on the Colossian church - the local church today 'As you have received Christ Jesus as the Lord of your life, so now walk in Him'
How? - Rom 12 1-2 'Be transformed by the renewal of your mind' We joyfully in the Holy Spirit give ourselves as living sacrifices for His service.

*vs 7 'We are ROOTED and Build up in Him'
We have a strong foundation - PS1; Jer 17;8.
This is who we are - We are rooted and built up in Christ by nature.

*vs 8-9. Paul's desire is for Christians to resist false teaching,' keep your eyes on Jesus and delight in God's Word. When we have Christ we have everything we need. Col 1:15!
What a Privilege my friends - seeing Jesus is seeing what God is like.

*We have been given the FULLNESS of Christ, who is the head over every power and authority.

* vs 13—15 God made us alive with Christ, He forgave us all our sins and yes, God disarmed the powers and authorities -Isa 54:17 - 'No weapon formed me shall prosper'

* vs 18 AS WE GROW IN CHRIST FAITH, LET GOD'S WORD BE OUR GUIDE.

***3 WAYS TO DEAL WITH WAVERING FAITH:**

- 1 Spend time with the LORD IN HIS WORD: PS 119:105; Isa 30:15
2. Remember God's goodness and His Faithfulness, In Faith we rise and sing - Lam. 3:22-23
- 3 We RELINQUISH all our anxieties, bring it before the Lord - 1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your cares on Him. Ask the Holy Spirit's help to set our eyes on Christ in times of doubt and fear.
