LUKE 13:34

Jesus grieves over Jerusalem

The Pharisees rejected Jesus -It was of no Spiritual significance to them. Jesus - John 17:17' Thy word is Truth - The world is still rejecting Gods word today!

PHILIPIANS 3. 17 - 21 ; 4.1 - WE ARE CITIZENS OF HEAVEN!

*When the Spirit of Christ indwells us we are able to live as a citizen of heaven * *1) vs 17 'we must always passionately follow Paul's example To have the mindset of Christ as in Phil 2:3-5.

*2) vs 18-19 We must at times seek for the leading of the Holy Spirit -asking the Lord for the gift of discernment- in this we will be able to recognise attitudes which are not Christlike as in Phil 2;3-5

*3) We are called to always patiently remind ourselves that we are citizens of heaven.
