Almighty God,


through your only Son you overcame death and opened to us the gate of everlasting life:

Rev'd John's Sermon Outline

John 21: 1-19

We note a REMARKABLE conversation between our Lord and the Apostle Peter.

* Peter Restored by Jesus, notwithstanding his recent frailties.

*vs 17. Jesus said to him, feed my sheep. This is an exhortation to the Rosewood Parish to be intentional about the work of ministry over the coming years: Prayer preparation and seeking the leading of the Holy Spirit.

* This is Living the Resurrection life - knowing the Spirit of Christ indwells us. (Rom 8:11)

Practical steps to live the Resurrection life:

*SURRENDER - We need to surrender our own ways and plans- PS 37:5

* SEEK - Matt 7:8 - Receive and confess 'Lord I believe, help my unbelief!'

*3. SOW.- We have received information from Bishop Cam about the Future population growth in Rosewood. We have every reason to pray our participation into being . (TO SOW)
