



- * vs1 Being Strong, walking in the Grace of God, in Christ Jesus, Our Source is in Jesus Christ.
- Eph 2:8-9. "For by Grace you have been saved, through Faith NOT by WORKS.
- *vs 2 -3 Remain equipped to pass on the Gospel. Do our Best as a worker approved by God. Never to be ashamed as you stand firm on Biblical Truth, even when we face adversity..
- *vs 5-6. How we should minister and relate to one another when God's grace is manifested in our lives when we face difficult times in our family or in the church family. Paul gave three metaphors to illustrate the duties of a Christian.
- * there will be no victory for the soldier if he is not involved in his soldiering.
- *there will be no "wreath" for the athlete unless he keeps the rules
- *There will be no harvest for the farmer, unless he toils at his farming
- *vs7-11. God speaks to us through His word- God shows us timeless Truths on how to apply His truths in our lives. Yes God will give us understanding (JER 33:3) "A true saving-vs 11-13"
- * vs14-15 Like Timothy, .We are exhorted to be consistent and diligent in our study of Gods word.
- * PARDONING GRACE Mark 11:25 Only by the Grace of God .

The inherent nature of God's Grace demonstrates His willingness to forgive human Frailties. Forgiveness is extended to all when we repent and live a life of forgiveness. PS 32: 5

* HEALING GRACE. .Ps 147:3. "He heals the Brokenhearted and binds up their wounds"
